

ILLEGAL SIDEWALK MECHANICS



REPAIRING VEHICLES ON PUBLIC PROPERTIES IS A CITY ORDINANCE THAT WILL RESULT IN FINES

Many street mechanics solicit customers outside of auto parts stores, and most are unlicensed and uninsured. Street mechanics create quality of life issues and pose unsafe environmental problems (e.g., improper disposal of parts and fluids, unsafe sidewalk and parking lot conditions).

Please be respectful to your community and do not repair vehicles on public properties. Do not patronize mechanics operating illegally.

PHILADELPHIA § 9-207 (1) Prohibited Conduct. No person who owns, operates or controls, or who is employed in the business of repairing motor vehicles shall use any portion of City sidewalks or streets for the repair of motor vehicles.
