Financial Assistance for Undergraduates

• The General Grant

Grace Baptist Church of Germantown offers general scholarship aid to fulltime undergraduate students who are members of the congregation and meet the following criteria:

1. Active membership
2. Participation in one or more activities or ministries
3. Academic average of 2.5 or better
4. Enrollment at an accredited institution of higher learning

For the 2020-2021 Academic Year, the amount of the grant is \$1,300. Students may apply for each of four years of undergraduate work. Students in an approved five-year Program, may apply for five years.

• Single Competitive Scholarships with Additional Criteria

The members of the Scholarship Committee will discuss the details of the following scholarships with prospective applicants:

The Reverend Jeremiah A. Wright Scholarship (High academic performance at 88% level or 3.35 in a 4.0 system and financial need).

The Brian Vertreace Memorial Scholarship (\$1,000 for students pursuing careers in the visual, performance or media arts).

The G. Daniel Jones Scholarship (\$1,000 for a student who exhibits high spiritual, social and academic values as indicated by a cumulative average of 3.3 the first year; 3.4 thereafter).

NEW! Dr. Roland and Mrs. Pauline Lucas Book Award (\$500 for a student preparing for a career in any of the healthcare professions. (Medicine, Nursing, Dentistry, Medical Social Work, etc.). Criteria for this new book award: • A graduating high school senior or a student who has completed his or her freshman, sophomore or junior year is eligible. • Academic average of 3.0 or better. The student must provide an official transcript. • A student may apply for the award, for each of the four years for the undergraduate degree.

NEW! Mrs. Salivia Sharpe Wilkins Award This fund for technical and commercial education was established by the estate of Mrs. Salivia Sharp Wilkins. Support is provided for a student pursuing a certificate program.

Financial Assistance for Graduate Study

The church offers a one-time grant of \$500 for graduate students.

The Sherri Woodard-Derricotte Scholarship for Graduate Studies (\$1,000)

Criteria for this competitive grant for full time study include a grade point average of 2.8.
