The Philadelphia Police Department's Youth Advisory Commission (YAC) is a youth-led initiative, consisting of members ranging in ages from 14-18 yrs old. The Commission focuses on topics crucial to youth – including public safety and police/community interactions.

The aim of the YAC, is for youth to work alongside police personnel on the co-production of public safety to address relevant issues, and to serve as a liaison between youth in communities and members of the Philadelphia Police Department.

Members will have opportunities to meet with the Police Commissioner and her executive staff on a periodic basis, to advocate for changes and resources centered from a youth's perspective.
