

Reverend Kenneth L. Woodson

Reverend Kenneth L. Woodson is a native of Burkeville, Virginia. He graduated from Luther H. Foster High School in Nottoway, Virginia finishing second in his class. He attended Virginia State University (College), where he was elected to “*Who’s Who Among Students in American Universities and Colleges*” and was also Student Body President, a Distinguished Military Student and honor graduate. He served a brief stint in the United States Army and was awarded The Bronze Star Medal.

He is a former Lay Leader in the United Methodist Church, and a Life Member of the Connectional Lay Council of the A. M. E. Zion Church. He received a Master of Divinity Degree from United Lutheran Seminary along with the Certificate of Preparation in Black Church Ministry on May 19, 2019, and the Master of Sacred Theology Degree on May 17, 2023.
